CHANGE OF EXAMINATION CENTRE AND IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR APUNTSSE-2024.

- 1. All the eligible candidates for the post of Multitasking Staff (MTS) who have been assigned Kendriya Vidyalaya, Pasighat as their Examination Centre are hereby informed that owing to administrative reasons, this examination centre has been shifted to Daying Ering College of Teacher Education located at Diiking, Pasighat. The Examination Date, Timing and Centre Code (L) will remain the same. Candidates are advised to re-print their admit cards accordingly.
- 2. Ensure to print the admit card on an A4 size paper in colour and keep it in good condition.
- 3. The Timings of all examinations are from 10 AM to 1 PM of 3 (Three) hours duration each. Ignore any misprint of Timing in your admit cards.
- 4. Following are the correct Examination Centre Codes. Ignore misprints if any, in your admit cards OR candidates may re-download the admit card. (Please use the correct Centre Code, If in doubt, confirm it from your Invigilators):

Section C: General Knowledge: 100 Marks (50 Questions)

Each question carries 2 (Two) Marks

Total Marks: 300.

There will be No Negative Marking.

- 7. The question papers for all the posts may contain some questions specific to the subject domain of the post applied for. The standard of such questions will be basic in nature.
- 8. It is advisable for outstation candidates to visit the allotted Exam Centre a day in advance to familiarise yourself with the location and to avoid any last-minute confusion.
- Bring your admit card and only one valid photo ID in original (such as an Aadhaar Card, Pan Card, Service ID or Voter ID Card). No other documents will be allowed into the examination premises.
- 10. CANDIDATES WILL BE ALLOWED TO CARRY ONLY THE FOLLOWING THREE ITEMS INTO THE EXAM PREMISES: ADMIT CARD, ONE PHOTO ID AND ONE BOTTLE OF WATER (IF NECESSARY) WITH THE LABEL REMOVED.
- 11. Do not carry any prohibited items such as mobile phones, wristwatches, car and bike keys, money wallets or purses, all kinds of electronic gadget, calculators, books, notes, tobacco products and any kind of edible item.
- 12. The University will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any personal belongings during the Examinations.
- 13. Candidates on any kind of prescribed medication OR Special Abilities may inform their respective Examination Centre Superintendents well before time.
- 14. THE EXAMINEES WILL BE PROVIDED WITH BLACK BALL PEN AND OMR SHEET INSIDE THE EXAMINATION HALL. DO NOT BRING ANY PEN OR PENCIL, ERASER, WHITENER FROM OUTSIDE.
- 15. Reach the exam centre well before the scheduled time for frisking and other necessary formalities. Entry will be allowed w.e.f 8 AM upto 9.45 AM.
- 16. Candidates will not be allowed to enter the Examination premises 15 minutes before the scheduled start of the examinations. Entry to the examination premises will be Closed after 9.45 am.
- 17. Candidates will not be allowed to leave the Examination Hall before the expiry of the full examination time. They are directed to sit for the entire 3 Hours of the examination.
- 18. FOR NATURE'S CALL, candidates will NOT BE ALLOWED the leave the examination hall before the expiry of 1 Hour after the start of the examination and in the last 30 minutes of the examination. They will allowed for nature's call for a maximum period of TWO MINUTES ONLY.
- 19. Ensure you submit your answer sheets and other materials before leaving the exam hall.
